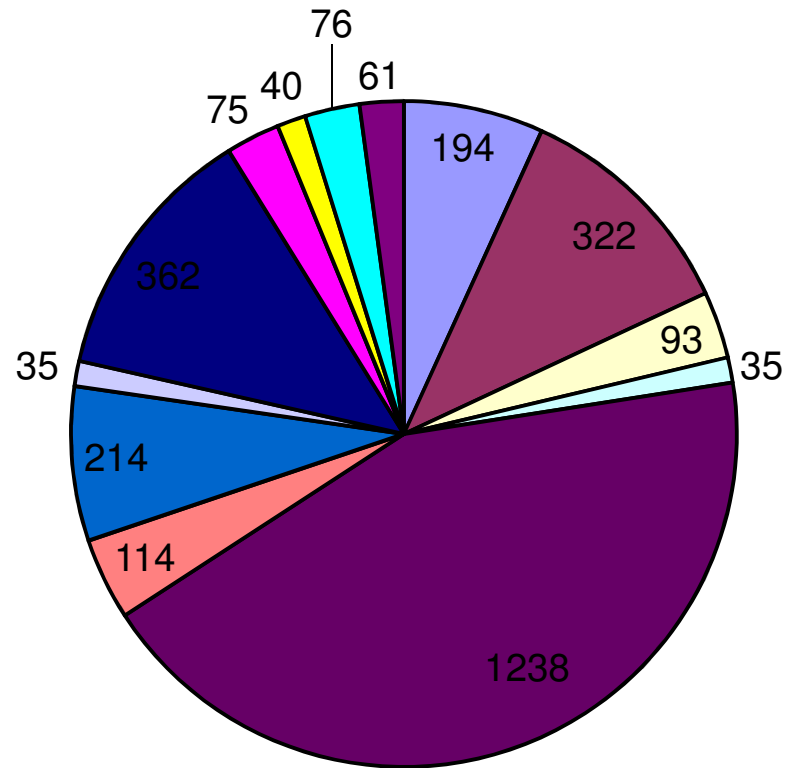

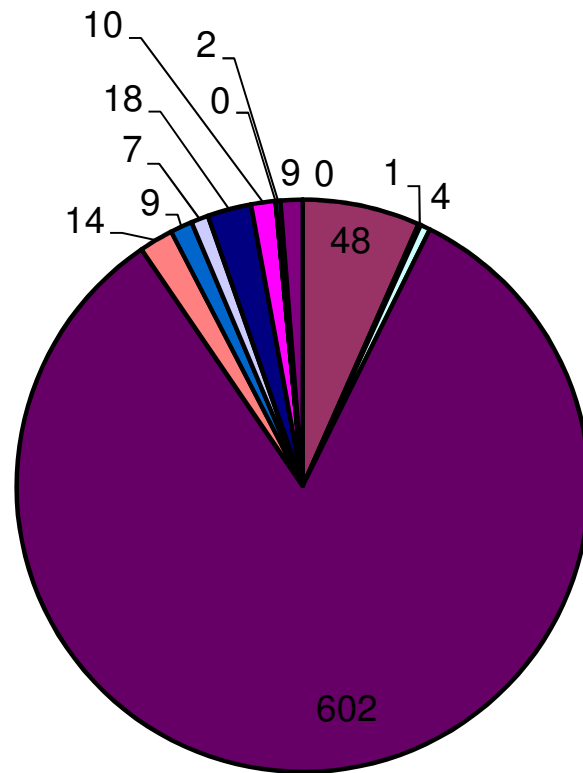


Distribution of Genre Families



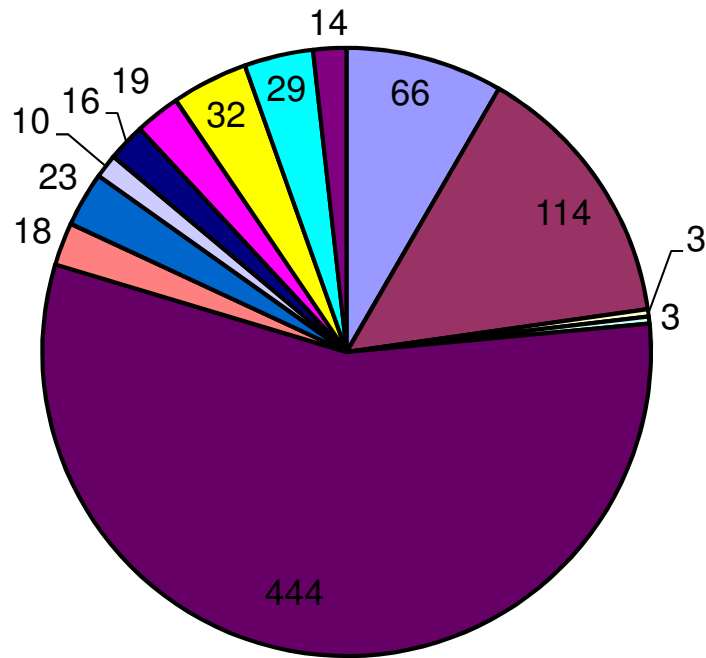

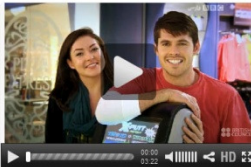


Project objectives

Innovative features to add to old-fashioned exercise types

- **Wordlists** for genres and disciplines – with links directly to the relevant concordance lines on the Sketch Engine open site
- **Video clips** of lecturers and students
- **Camtasia video recordings** of writing-in-progress, e.g. showing editing processes
- **Links to online articles** in open-access journals, plus m/c exercises to judge e.g. most appropriate paraphrase for given purpose, in a given context
